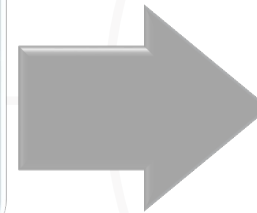

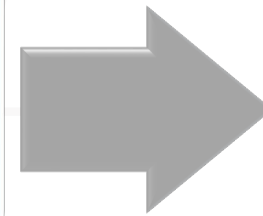

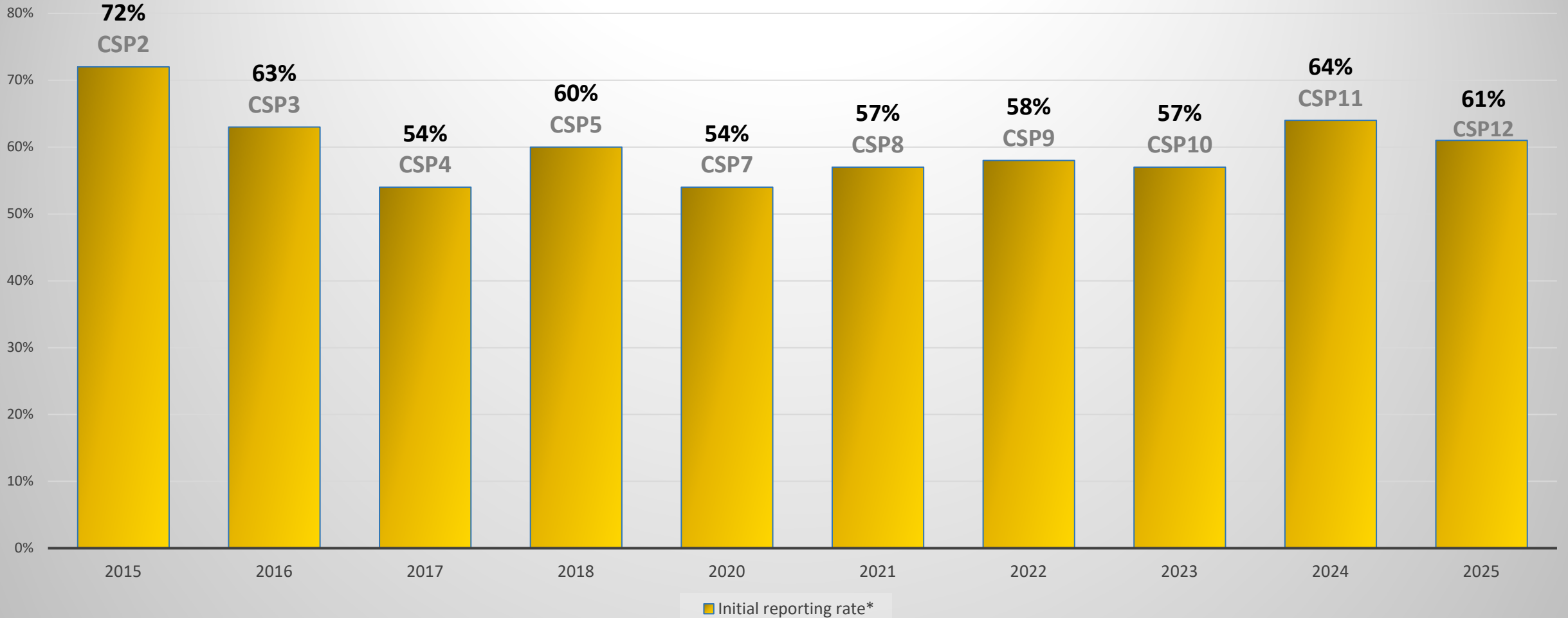

Comparison to previous CSPs

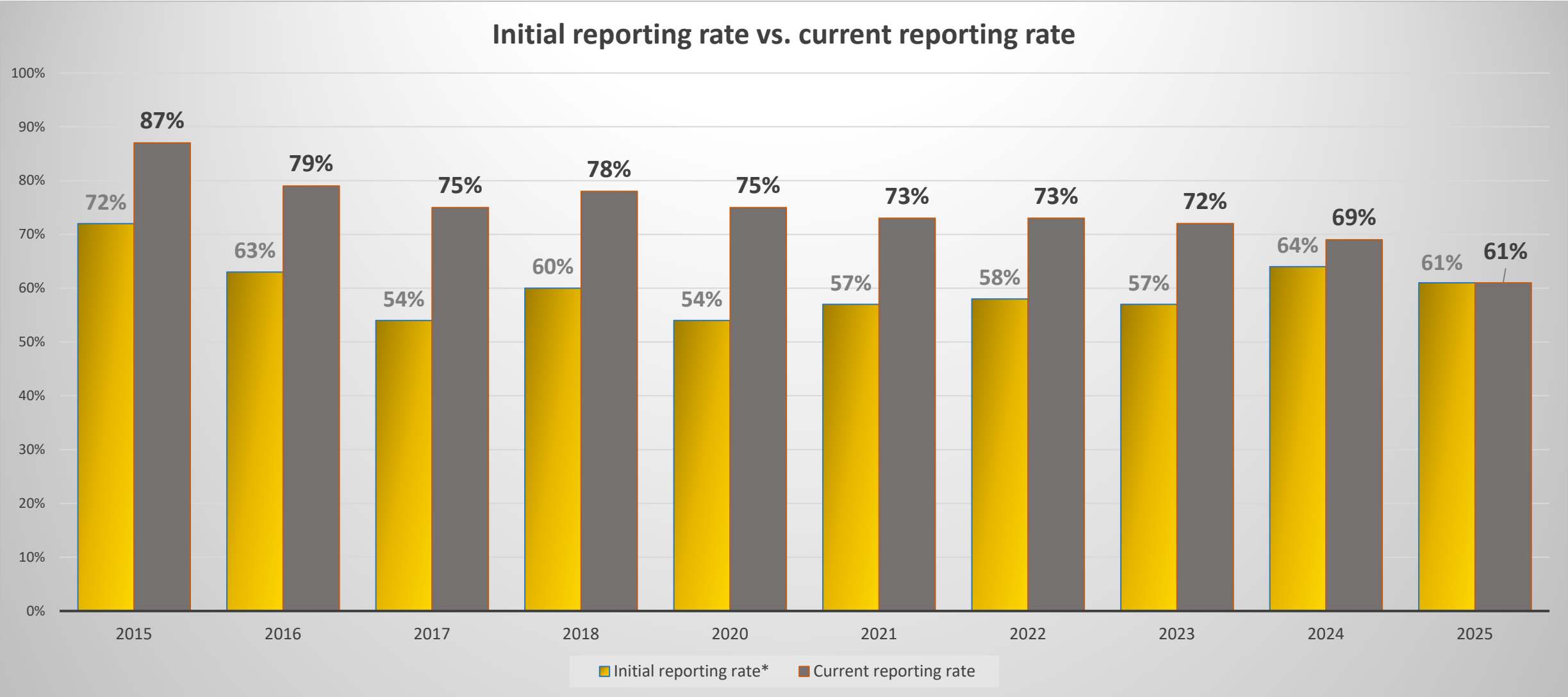
Reporting rates presented at first CSP following reporting year

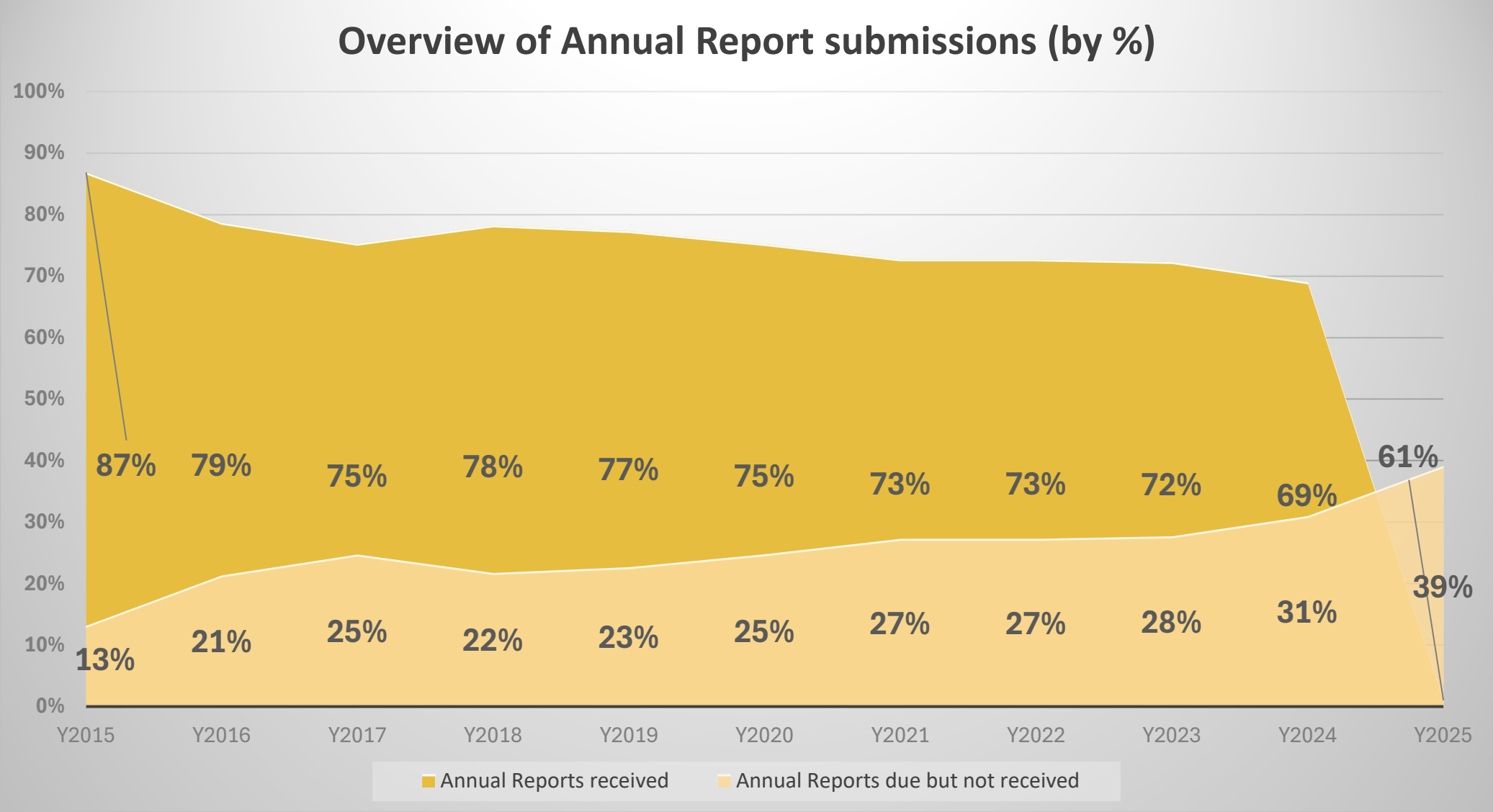

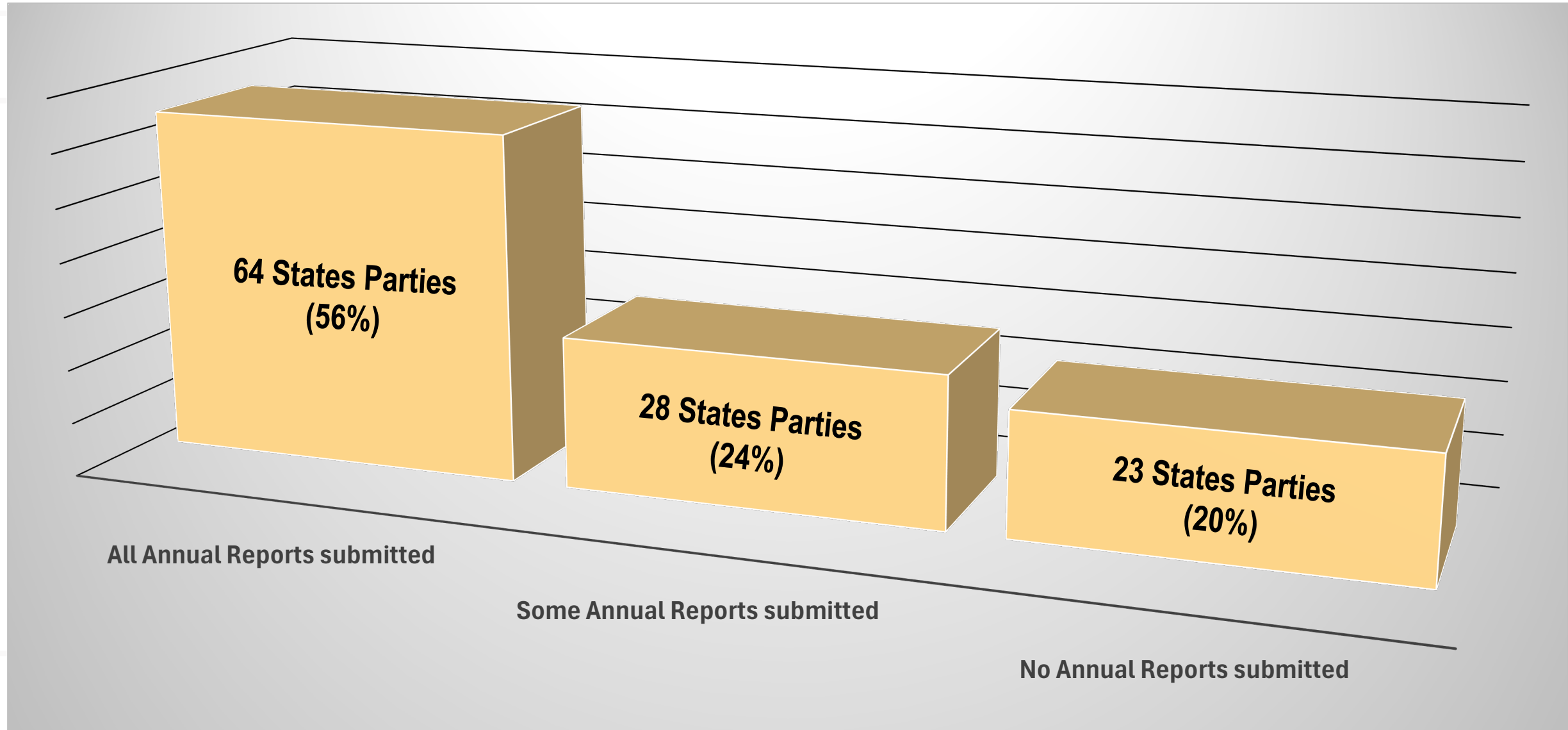

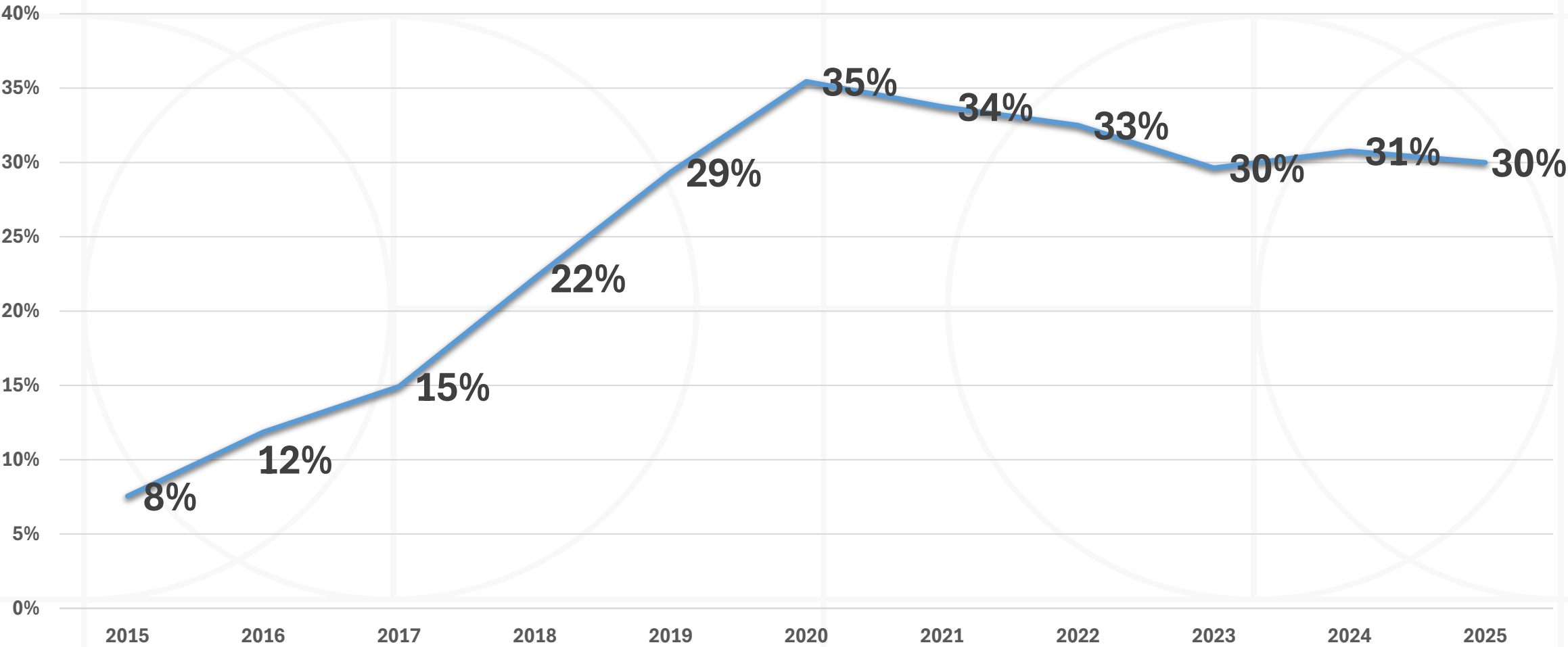

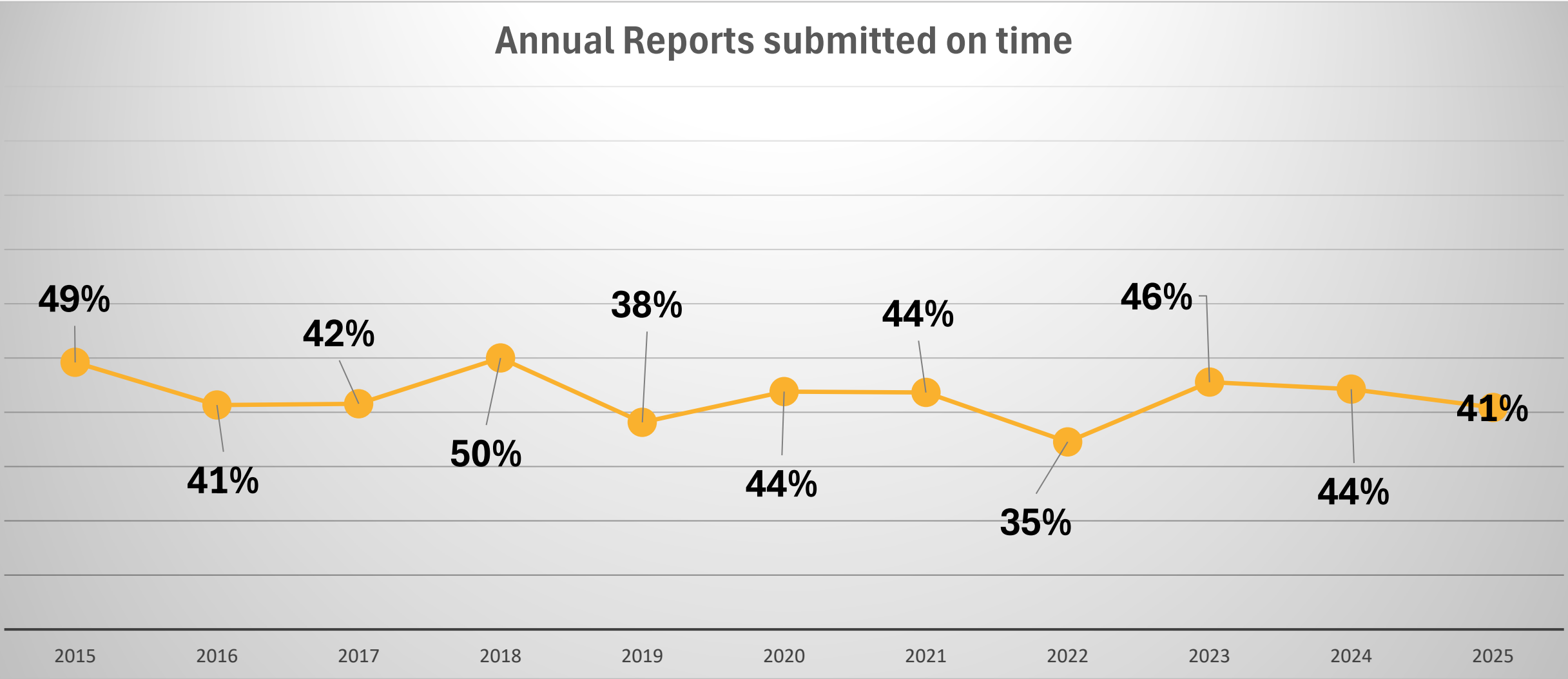

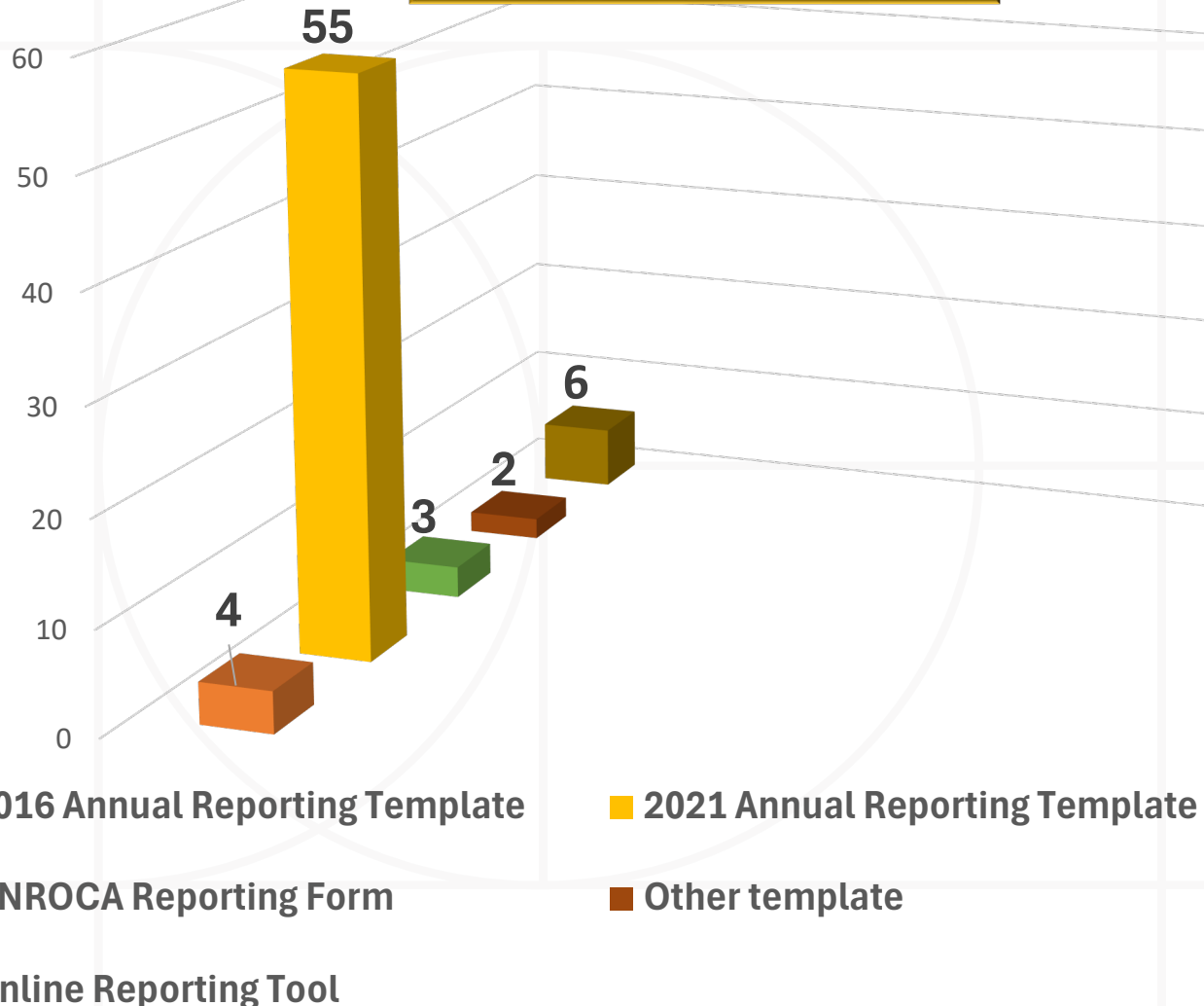

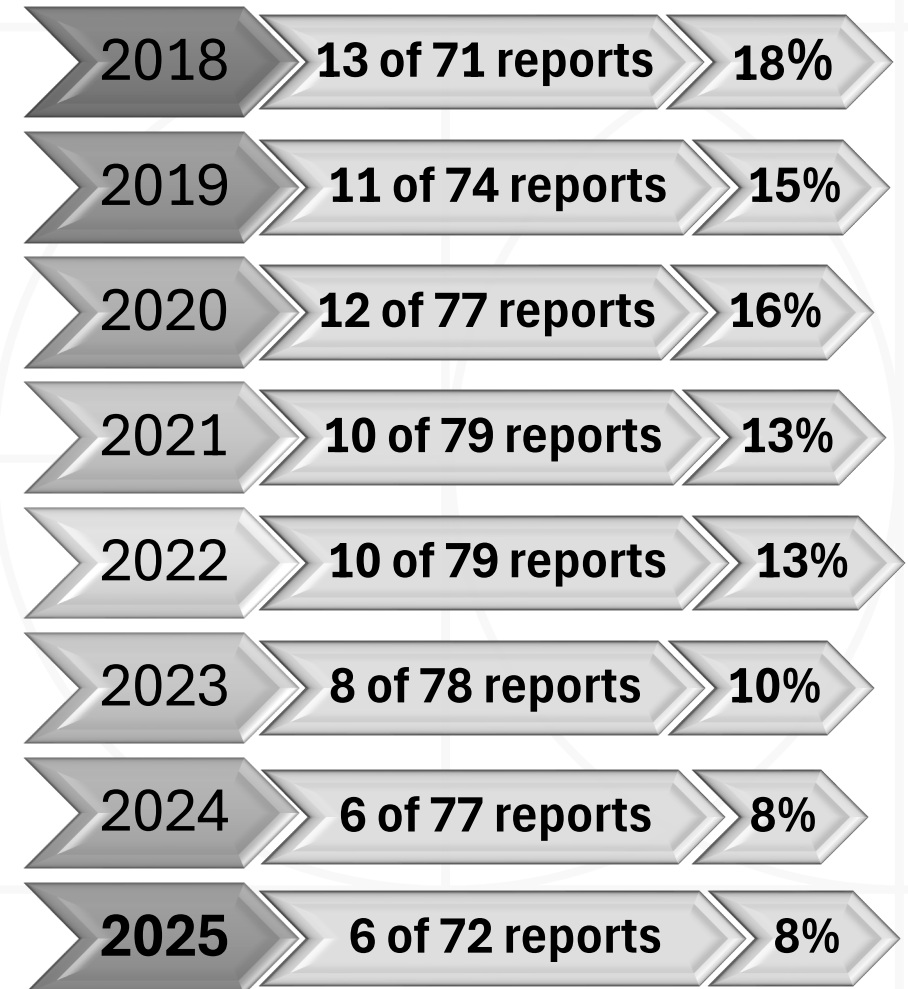

Use of online reporting tool

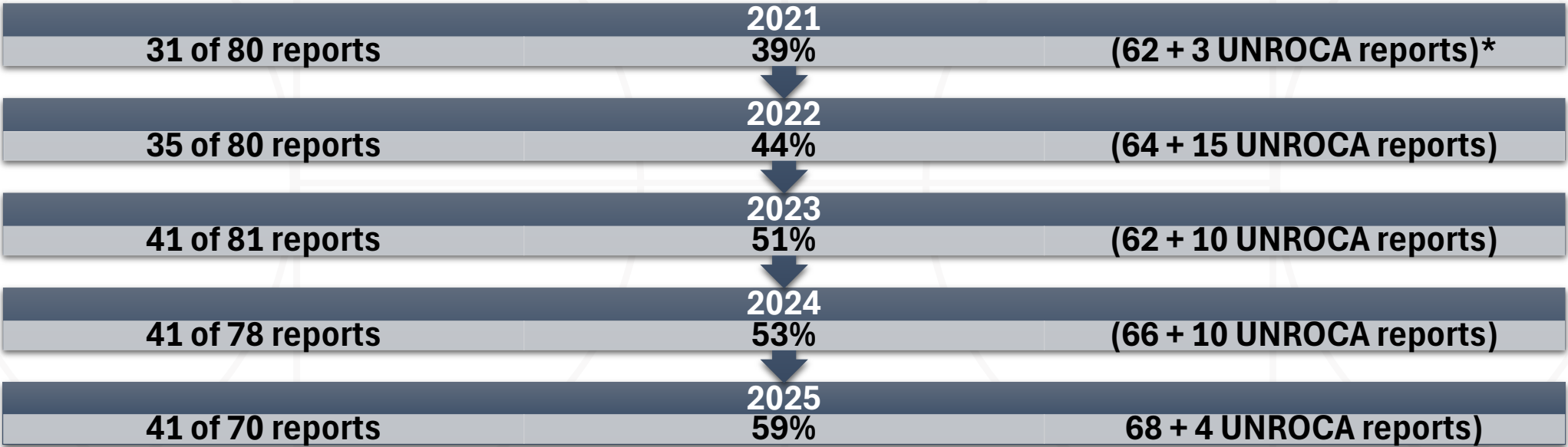
