



Statement by
The Republic of Slovenia

at the

**Twelfth Conference of States Parties to the Arms Trade Treaty,
Transparency and Reporting, Item 6**

Geneva, 24-28 August 2026

Madam President,

Slovenia aligns itself with the statement delivered by the European Union and would like to add the following in its national capacity.

Slovenia attaches great importance to transparency and reporting as essential elements of the effective implementation of the Arms Trade Treaty. Timely and comprehensive reporting contributes to confidence among States Parties and strengthens the transparency and accountability of the international arms trade.

Slovenia remains committed to fulfilling its reporting obligations under Article 13 of the Treaty and submitted its Annual Report for the 2025 calendar year within the deadline.

In the process of submitting our Annual Report, we experienced some minor technical difficulties with the online reporting system, particularly when uploading the report. The system did not immediately process the uploaded file successfully, and additional attempts were required before the submission could be completed.

While these technical difficulties were resolved and did not prevent Slovenia from submitting its report on time, our experience demonstrates the importance of ensuring that the ATT online reporting tools are reliable, stable and user-friendly.

In this regard, Slovenia welcomes the ongoing work aimed at improving the ATT reporting process and its online tools.

We also encourage States Parties that have not yet fulfilled their reporting obligations to submit their outstanding report.

Slovenia remains committed to transparency and reporting under the Arms Trade Treaty and supports continued practical efforts to facilitate reporting and strengthen the effectiveness of the Treaty.
